Sam Mosse, Chief Risk and Sustainability Officer, formally represents and is accountable for sustainability, overseeing a dedicated Sustainability team who are responsible for the day-to-day management, monitoring and reporting of the sustainability strategy and supporting the businesses to deliver our commitments.
